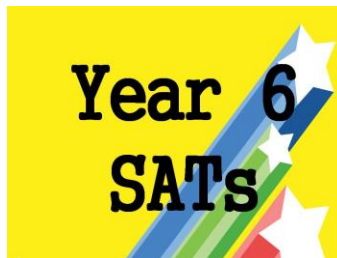


Barlow Hall Primary School

Year 3 and 4 Enterprise Day

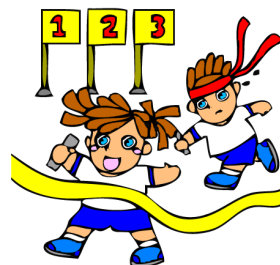
Year 3/4 are enthusiastically working hard on planning their business ideas for next week's enterprise day. They are currently working on their business plans and advertising,

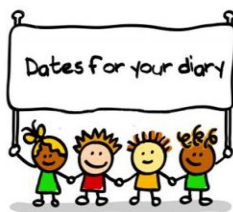
