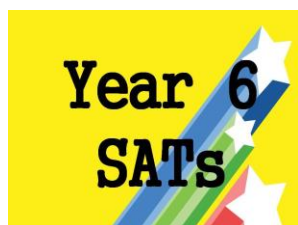

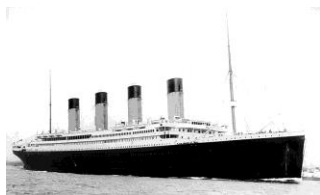


Bee a Reader Challenge

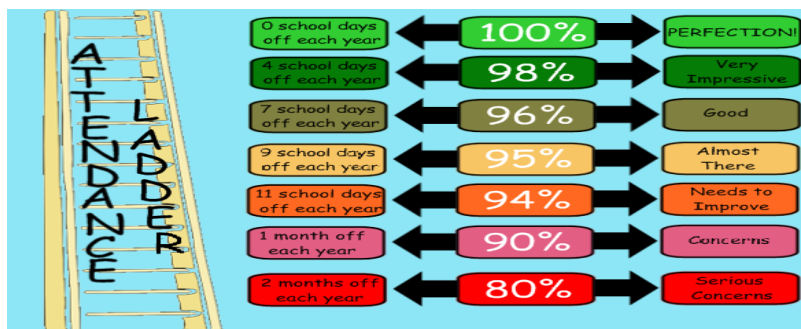
Please note that the cut off dates used for the children's reports and for the Attendance Assemblies are different so there may be a small difference in attendance percentages for your child.

The DWP are implementing the expansion of Universal Credit in jobcentres across Greater Manchester. All jobcentres in Greater Manchester currently deliver the Universal Live Service and the expansion has seen the introduction of the digital service in the following Manchester jobcentres.

Alexandra Park, Didsbury, Rusholme, Newton Heath and Openshaw. The expansion of the Universal Credit Full Service is expected to be completed by November 2018 for new claimants, the last two job centres, Wythenshawe and Cheetham hill will be introducing the full credit service from 25th July, These are Wythenshawe and Cheetham Hill. Longsight Jobcentre is due to close soon and services will be delivered from Rusholme job centre.
