All of this work put school funding on the agenda and it may well have changed some minds. That's a very exciting thought. This doesn't necessarily mean that we will be offered a solution. 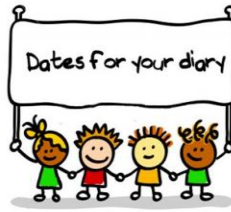
