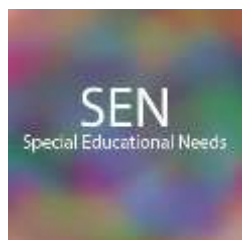

### SENCO update from Mrs Rees



This week has been SEND review week and Mrs Rees met with all teachers to discuss any vulnerable learners in their class. Each term children's strengths and difficulties are discussed and a plan of support decided on and implemented. This plan is then reviewed at the following term's SEND week and this coincides with the setting of the targets for the children's Individual Learning Plans which teachers

will share with parents and carers. Teacher will set SMART targets which can be supported at home by parents and carers and we thank you for your support.



Our Assistant Psychologist Ruby Nobel has started new intervention groups for this half term. We have focussed on the year 6's and delivering a program of additional transition support for two groups of children. The intervention is called 'Smart Moves'. We also have two Lego therapy groups up and running

and will be focussing on expanding the delivery of Lego therapy so more children can access it.



Emily Alderson our speech and language therapist has been working with key children and providing 'staff surgeries' for teachers. This is an opportunity for teachers to ask for advice and guidance around

specific concerns or strategies they have already been using. I work closely with Emily to meet the communication needs of the children and have recently become an 'ELKLAN Champion'. I attended the ELKLAN Champion meeting last week where we discussed a speech and language need called 'Developmental Language Disorder'. Recent research shows that, on average, 2 children out of a class of 30 may have 'DLD'.



Mrs Rees will continue to offer fortnightly SEND 'drop in' sessions for parents on Thursday mornings. Book in through the office if you require an appointment to discuss any concerns and I'll be able to offer a 30- minute slot.

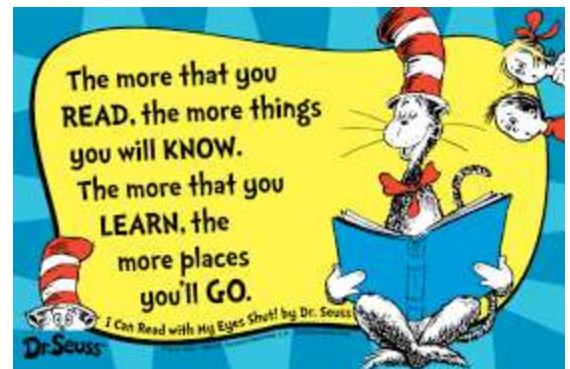
