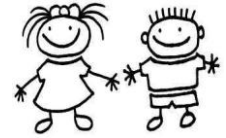
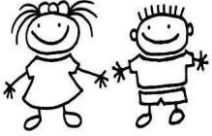


Nursery Weekly Learning Update

Literacy

Our stories this week were Who's a Clever Baby Then? Avocado Baby and What Does Daddy Do? We have been practising hearing initial sounds in words and writing the letter with correct formation. We use speed sounds jingles to help the children remember how to form the letters.
