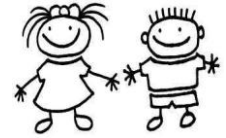
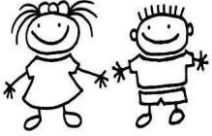


# Nursery Weekly Learning Update

## 20<sup>th</sup> March 2015



### Literacy

Our story this week was Jasper's Beanstalk. We learnt the signs for days of the week and matched capital letters up to days of the week cards. We practised writing the letter b and drew beans and beanstalks. Our role play area is Jasper's Garden and we have been pretending to cut the grass and collect slugs and snails

### Maths

We have been estimating this week - how many scoops of compost will fill different sized plant pots and how many scoops of water will fill different sized watering cans. We have been learning the language full, half full, empty.

### Outdoors

We have been making words with letter tiles and playing matching games. We have been spending more time in our Mud Kitchen now that it is getting a little warmer. We have also been observing the changes to our bulbs and spring flowers.

### HELP AT HOME

- Next week we have eggs arriving in school that will hatch out into chicks. The chicks will stay in school for two weeks. Talk with your child about the hen lifecycle
- If your child still finds it tricky to zip up their coat help them to practise this. We have talked about being resilient and not giving up!

### Understanding the World

We talked about being a gardener as a job linked to our Jasper's Beanstalk book and looked at some gardening tools. We have been making close observations of our Grass Heads and updating our Grass Head books. Some of us have made different hairstyles for them and next week we will decide if we want our Grass Heads to have a hair cut!
