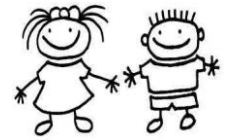
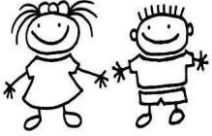


# Nursery Weekly Learning Update

### Literacy

We have been looking at non fiction books about babies and learning facts about babies. Thank you to everyone who sent in a story for us to read on World Book Day - we loved listening to lots of new stories.

### Maths

We have been talking about language short and tall. We made duplo towers the same size as a collection of giraffes and we measured ourselves with the giraffe measuring stick. We made different length snakes out of playdoh and compared them.
