



Year 1
Summer 2: Curriculum Overview

Topic
<p>Our whole school topic this half term is Our Planet.</p> <p>In Year 1, we will be learning about Weather in the UK and Around the World. We will learn about different seasons and types of weather. As part of the topic we will also look at how changes in weather can affect plant and animal life. We will also be competing some local field studies linked to weather. Furthermore, we be working with our Artist in Residence Mrs Law on a project linking to the weather.</p>
English
<p>We will complete our work in English through different texts. Firstly, There's a Rang Tang in my bedroom By James Sellick. Using this story, we will complete oral language work, drama, short writing activities, comprehension, grammar activities and the children will complete a longer piece of writing using a plan, write, edit sequence of lessons. We will be looking at two poems this term, Crazy Mayonnaisy Mum by Julia Donaldson and My Friend by Emily Hearn. Guided Reading will be delivered every day for all the children, as will our whole class phonics lessons. Next week children in Year 1 will be completing their Phonics Screening Check in school.</p>
Maths
<p>This half term we will be recapping the 4 operations (addition subtraction division and multiplication- word problems will be taught in this time). We will also be learning time (half past and o'clock). We will also be revisiting 2d and 3 d shape.</p>
Science
<p>Year 1 will continue with the topic plants. We will be observing our plants grow. We are completing a diary and planting them outside. We will be looking at deciduous and evergreen trees in our local area and naming tree around school. We will continue to spend time looking at the 4 seasons as we come into summer.</p>
